ANAT Bespoke is a flexible, partnership program that brings together artists, researchers, organisations and industries to develop ambitious projects at the intersection of art, science, technology and culture.

ANAT Bespoke supports tailored pathways for science and technology industry and sector partners to work with artists. This enables space for creative experimentation, deep research and connections whilst creating new knowledge and amplifying artistic research projects.

This bespoke approach provides unique assistance to the project, supporting artists and their partners with more time and energy for experimentation, deep research and meaningful exchange.

Why Partner with an artist to undertake ANAT Bespoke?

Partners are invited into high-value creative research collaborations that:

- Engage artists as critical thinkers and innovators
- Activate science and/or technology research or facilities in new ways
- Support ethical, future-focused and socially engaged inquiry
- Build long-term relationships across art, science, industry and community
- Contribute to new knowledge systems
- Generate cultural, intellectual and reputational value via new networks

 - Supporting experimental, interdisciplinary practice

 - Staff time, mentoring or specialist expertise
 - Research access, datasets or field sites

How It Works

1. **Project concept is identified** (partner-led or co-initiated with the artist)
 2. **Submission:** includes two phases: 1. Initial EOI; 2. Final selection
 3. **ANAT review and acceptance:** successful project/s notified in November
 4. **Partners, artist & ANAT confirm** with the finalisation of an agreement
 5. **Project delivered collaboratively**, with regular reflection touchpoints across the process
 6. **Outcomes shared** in ways appropriate to all parties
